40331: Flame-retardant weighted lap blanket Anne-Lore® (granulate)

Weighted articles are used as a soothing aid for people who are subject to stress and anxiety related factors or for people with sleeping problems.

A weighted blanket soothes in the same way as a hug would do. Studies of the use of weighted articles have shown that for some patients they reduce the need for restraints and medication.

A weighted article filled with granules perfectly follows the contours of the body. It also has the advantage that you don't need a lot of filling volume to apply enough pressure, so that the article itself doesn't have to be really thick. This is practical in a warm environment and easy to maintain.

Purpose:

- Reduce anxiety and stress
- Relieve restlessness and irritability
- Improve concentration

Attention:

- The combination of a weighted blanket and a reduced lung capacity or a weak musculature may involve a risk. In this case, follow the use of the blankets closely, or consult a doctor if in doubt.
- Consider the risk of tripping if a weighted blanket has fallen to the floor.

Guidelines for use:

Lay the lap blanket over the legs in length or width depending on the posture in the seat. Fold the blanket in half for more local pressure.

Quality: 1010, flame-retardant, breathable material, high tear resistance

Stuffing: flame-retardant plastic granulate

The weighted articles are made of a flame-retardant fabric.

Washing instructions for weighted blankets:

1. *Washing* Separate washing at 60°C gentle programme with a little detergent in a washing bag. Duvets weighing more than 6 kg are divisible so that each part can be washed separately.
2. *Rinse* DON'T ADD FABRIC CONDITIONER.
3. *Dry* Dry very briefly at a low temperature in a laundry bag in the dryer or hang to dry. Do not dry together with moisture-retaining textiles (like cotton,...).
